- Up to 4 pieces can be submitted. Maximum size is 20 x 60 inches.
- You can submit: drawings, paintings, poetry, freestanding/fully supported sculptures & multi-media works. No video or audio works, please.
- This is a curated show. All submissions must be approved by the submission committee & adhere to BIST's anti-discrimination policies.

- All work must be dropped off at the BIST office.
- Artists must provide their name, title & price for their work (if it's for sale), & sign a damage wavier at the time of drop off.
